STUDENT DRESS CODE

The Central Yorke School community believe that wearing a school uniform benefits the whole community as it develops a sense of belonging and pride in the school and reduces the cost and competition associated with alternative clothing.

UNIFORM ITEMS

The Governing Council has ensured that students have a range of clothing options available:

| Item | Description |
|----------------|---|
| CYS Jacket | Black with collar with CYS red monogrammed logo |
| CYS Jumper | Red with CYS black monogrammed logo |
| CYS Polo shirt | Red with CYS black monogrammed logo |
| CYS Shorts | Black with CYS red monogrammed logo |
| Winter skirt | White, black & red checked |
| Dress | White, black & red checked |
| Track pants | Black track pants with no logo |
| Hat | Red wide brimmed hat |

HAT POLICY

Students are required to wear protective hats (bucket hats or broad-brimmed hats) during Terms 1 and 4 for all outdoor activities organised by the school, including recess and lunch, or as directed by the Principal or Teacher. Hats must be removed while indoors, and caps are not permitted. This policy ensures sun protection and aligns with the school's Sun Smart guidelines.

UNACCEPTABLE ITEMS

To maintain a professional and consistent standard of appearance, the following items are not permitted:

- Non-uniform items (including jackets, hoodies, leggings, jeans)
- Coloured tops or hoddies under school polo shirts
- School uniform items that have been shortened (e.g., dresses and shorts should remain long enough to sit just above the knee)
- Unsafe footwear (e.g., thongs, ugg boots, Crocs, backless shoes, sandals)
- Excessive make-up
- Caps or school hats that have been defaced with graffiti
- Visible tattoos and excessive piercings that do not align with the school's professional appearance standards.

NEW RECEPTIONS

As we welcome new Receptions into our school we provide each transitioning student with one shirt and hat as they start their schooling journey with us.

SCHOOL UNIFORM POLICY CONTINUED

Motifs and Logos:

- Only school emblems are acceptable on items of the school uniform. Other motifs or logos are not permitted. This includes on hats.
- Students may wear plain black or white long-sleeved shirts under their polo tops during cold weather. This ensures students remain comfortable while adhering to the school's uniform standards.

Out-of-Uniform Procedures:

- Students who are out of uniform must report to the front office to receive a uniform sticker. In some cases, students may be asked to change or remove unacceptable items. Home class teachers are responsible for contacting families to discuss uniform concerns and recording the issue in Daymap.

Non-Compliance:

- Non-compliance with reasonable instructions regarding uniform will be escalated through the Behaviour Management Policy.

Financial Assistance:

- Support is available for families experiencing financial difficulties in meeting the school uniform requirements.
